

RING SIZE GUIDE

IMPORTANT!

Print this page out at 100% size and follow one of the methods below to get an accurate measurement of your ring size.

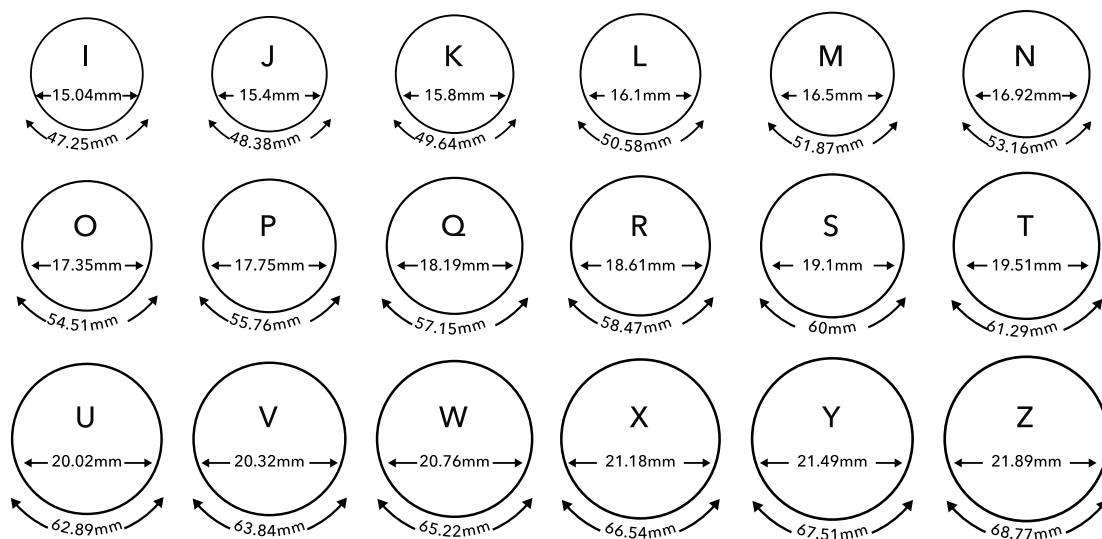
Check the measurements below with a ruler to make sure your page is printed at the correct size.

METHOD 1: MEASURE AN EXISTING RING

Use the guide below to check against the size of an existing ring. The circle should align with the inside edge of your own ring.



METHOD 2: MEASURE YOUR FINGER

1. Cut a thin strip of paper and wrap it around your chosen finger.
2. Mark on the paper where the ends meet.
3. Measure the length against a ruler and use the guide above to see what the closest match is in circumference and what the corresponding size is (eg 50.5mm = L). If you are between sizes you can record it as a half size. (e.g 50.7mm = L 1/2)

METHOD 3: USE THIS RING SIZER TOOL

1. Cut the ring sizer as indicated and cut a slot as shown.
 2. Thread the end through the slot and place the sizer around your finger.
 3. Pull the end so it fits comfortably around your finger and it can easily slide over your knuckle.
- Make a note of the letter the arrow is pointing to. This is your size.
